## **Two Vehicle Injury Crash – McKenzie Co**

**What:** Injury Crash

**Where:** Hwy 1806 MM 309 – 2 miles North of Watford City, ND

**When:** June 7, 2019 – 0940 AM

**Road Conditions:** Good

**Weather Conditions:** Cloudy

**Crash Involvement:** Vehicle/Vehicle

**Type of Crash:** Rear-End

**Vehicle No. 1:** 1998 Kenworth Semi  
**Driver No. 1:** Male, 57 - Sidney, MT – No Injuries  
**Restraints:** Seatbelt  
**Charges:** Pending completion of the investigation

**Vehicle No. 2:** 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe  
**Driver No. 2:** Female, 24 – Watford City, ND – Serious Injuries  
**Restraints:** Seatbelt  
**Charges:** No Charges

**NARRATIVE:** Vehicle 1 was traveling north bound on Hwy 1806. Vehicle 2 was stopped facing north on Hwy 1806, waiting to make a left turn into a residential driveway. Vehicle 2 was struck from behind by vehicle 1. Vehicle 1 continued to the north and came to a rest upright, facing northeast on the east shoulder of 1806. Vehicle 2 spun clockwise on the roadway and came to a rest between the north and south bound lanes of Hwy 1806 facing



northwest. Vehicle 2 then started on fire and was completely engulfed in flames. The driver of vehicle 2 was extricated while the vehicle was on fire.

This crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol. Charges are pending upon the completion of the investigation.
